

2023 RBC CANADIAN WOMEN ENTREPRENEUR AWARDS FINALISTS ANNOUNCED TODAY

TORONTO – <u>Women of Influence</u>+ announces the 2023 RBC Canadian Women Entrepreneur Awards finalists. This year marks the 31st anniversary of the program, which received over 11,000 nominations for women entrepreneurs from all over Canada. After an intensive judging review, 20 finalists were selected across seven categories. An additional five recipients were chosen to receive the Ones to Watch Award, which recognizes entrepreneurs who have launched businesses that have made an incredible impact in less than three years.

The women business owners and leaders in this shortlisted group were selected for their accomplishments in a wide range of industries including Sustainability, Urban Planning, Innovation in Healthcare, AI and Real Estate.
